About Tin Can Classes

Since 1898, when then-Assistant Secretary of the Navy Theodore Roosevelt first pushed for the acquisition of "torpedo boat destroyers" to protect against the new threat of seaborne, self-propelled explosive torpedoes, the U.S. Navy has bought or built just under 1,000 destroyers (plus hundreds of smaller destroyer escorts.)

Each Tin Can is grouped by size, weaponry, engineering and other design features into distinct destroyer classes (as are destroyer escorts.) Ten destroyer classes (and two destroyer escort class) are represented in this inaugural edition of Tin Can Calendar[©]. The classes are summarized in the following table:
